Student Grading Policy

This policy was approved by the American Academy Board of Directors on May 17, 2011

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define the grading scale used by American Academy as well as to define the late grading guidelines for the school to ensure consistency in grading.

Grading Scale

American Academy has a challenging grading scale in keeping with our high academic standards.

Late Work (Grades K-3)

Late assignments in grades kindergarten through third are marked 10% off the first day late, 20% off the second day late and 50% off if turned in within the unit.

Late Work (Grades 4-5)

Late assignments in grades fourth through fifth are marked 10% the first day, 50% off the second day and will receive no credit after that.

Late Work (Middle School)

Late assignments in grades sixth through eighth are marked 20% the first day, 50% off the second day and will receive no credit after that.
